



## Six Month Impact Assessment

*The difference the Clean Water Project made in Thnout Chroum.*

By comparing data collected during the baseline survey to data collected in the impact assessment survey (6 months after the end of working directly with the village) we are able to judge the difference JWOC's partnership with the village made.



- **23%** fewer people are using pit wells or hole wells (open, basic wells) due to the installation of **new hand pump wells** and fixing existing but broken wells.

- **15 %** more families have a water source **less than 10 meters** from their house reducing the time and effort expended in collection leaving more time for productive activities.

- **97%** families now have easy access enough **water all year** round because JWOC drills all new wells to a minimum depth of 25 meters.

- **8%** more people feel confident to **repair wells** due to JWOC's training with village elders.

- **59%** more people using **clean containers** to carry water from the source to their house reducing the risk of contamination.

- **97%** of people are using **water filters** to clean their water before drinking.

- **31%** more people are **brushing their teeth** more than once a day due to the basic hygiene training that took place.

- **8%** more people who had **not been ill** in the previous month.

- **67%** more people have enough water to **grow vegetables** in dry season because the new wells are able to supply more water than the old wells.

- **62%** of people plan to **replace** the ceramic part of the filter after two years showing their understanding of the importance of using water filters.
